## Book format \& print cost guidance

Before we can begin production and work out your printing costs, you will need to decide the trim size, binding and colour interior of your book.

Your book's trim size (the size of book) will impact on your final page count and subsequently your print cost (see page 2 for a list of popular trim sizes).
Simply put, the bigger the trim size the lower the page count.

## 1. Choosing your trim size

What size do you want your book to be?

- Small books start at 4 " $\times 6$ " ( $152 \times 100 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) and go up to 6.14 " $\times 9.21$ " $(234 \times 156 \mathrm{~mm})$
- Large books start at $6.69^{\prime \prime} \times 9.61^{\prime \prime}(244 \times 170 \mathrm{~mm})$ and go up to $8.5^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}(216 \times 280 \mathrm{~mm})$

Note: There are lots of trim sizes available and if you don't see the size you want listed on this document, please ask as we may be able to use a custom trim size for you.

## 2. Binding type

There are three types of book binding offered by our POD printers:

- Paperback (Perfect Bound): 216gsm card with either gloss or matte laminate finish
- Hardback (Case Laminate): Laminated board with either gloss or matte finish
- Hardback (Cloth-bound / blue or grey): Digital cloth finish on board with or without dust jacket in either gloss or matte finish

Note: Cloth-bound hardback books are only available in the 'small' book size.

- Don't forget you can have your book printed in more than one binding if you wish, just let us know.


## 3. Interior pages: mono or colour?

Black \& white interior: Does your interior contain text only, or are you happy for everything to be printed in black and white? In publishing we call this 'mono'.

- Note: Mono books are printed on crème paper by default but you can request white paper if you prefer

Colour interior: Will there be colour inside your book? Ignore the cover as this is always printed in colour; do you have images or illustrations that need to be printed in colour? If so, then we will use a heavier grade paper so that the ink doesn't bleed through and this paper will be used for all the interior pages.

## Your interior colour choices:

- Mono (black \& white)
- Printed on 80 gsm crème or 74 gsm white paper (white only for 'large' books)
- Can be text only or include greyscale images
- Colour
- Printed on 104gsm white paper
- Can feature colour text and/or images

NOTE: A mix of colour and black and white interior pages will be costed as colour.

## Trim Sizes

## Most common UK trade book sizes:

Mass market paperback $=\mathrm{B}$ format ( $5.06 \times 7.81$ inches $/ 129 \times 198 \mathrm{~mm}$ )
Mass market hardback and trade paperback $=$ Royal ( $6.14 \times 9.21$ inches $/ 156 \times 234 \mathrm{~mm}$ )
Poetry and non-fiction $=$ Demy ( $5.5 \times 8.5$ inches $/ 140 \times 216 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) - this size is less common but is also used for large format paperbacks and/or small format hardbacks

Children's picture book $=$ Square ( $8.5 \times 8.5$ inches $/ 216 \times 216 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) or portrait ( $8.5 \times 11$ inches / $216 \times 280 \mathrm{~mm}$ )

Textbooks $=$ Since they frequently include illustrations and diagrams, textbooks can range from $6 \times 9$ inches ( $152 \times 229 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) to A4 ( $8.268 \times 11.693^{\prime \prime} / 210 \times 297 \mathrm{~mm}$ )

## Most common US trade book sizes:

Mass market paperback $=5 \times 8$ inches $(127 \times 203 \mathrm{~mm})$
Mass market hardback and trade paperback $=6 \times 9$ inches ( $152 \times 229 \mathrm{~mm}$ )
Poetry and non-fiction = Demy ( $5.5 \times 8.5$ inches $/ 140 \times 216 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) - this size is less common but is also used for large format paperbacks and/or small format hardbacks

Children's picture book = Square ( $8.5 \times 8.5$ inches $/ 216 \times 216 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) or portrait ( $8.5 \times 11$ inches / $216 \times 280 \mathrm{~mm}$ )

Textbooks = Since they frequently include illustrations and diagrams, textbooks can range from $6 \times 9$ inches to $8.5 \times 11$ inches

These are just the most popular sizes; we can print a much wider range of trim sizes so if the size you want is not listed above, please ask and we'll let you know if we can do it.

## Pricing your book

Once you have made your choices, the following tables will help you to work out your book's estimated print cost.

Simply multiply your page count by the page cost and add to this the cost of the cover; this will be your print cost per book.

Note: The confirmed price will not be known until your book has been typeset and signed off and your final page count is known.

Example: Your typeset book has 85,000 words and is a black \& white interior paperback.
B format ( $5.06 \times 7.81$ inches / $129 \times 198 \mathrm{~mm}$ )

- A book at this size would result in a page count of approximately 284 pp

Royal ( $6.14 \times 9.21$ inches / $156 \times 234 \mathrm{~mm}$ )

- A book at this size would result in a page count of approximately 230pp
